AMX526 - PAGING MICROPHONE

3 x AMX526 paging microphones are connected to input 1 - 3.



The HS series features priority mode detection which allows channels to be muted when audio is detected on channels 1-3.

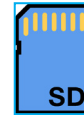
This can be used for applications like paging where background music is muted while the announcement occurs.



The priority section consists of three DIP switches and four POTS to configure the operation.

BGM VIA BLUETOOTH

Programmable Bluetooth 5.1 including, name/PIN and security settings



TONES & MESSAGES

Inbuilt Emergency tones (Alert/EVAC/ Intruder) and custom messages as MP3 files on a removable SD Card can be activated from either an external trigger such as an emergency button or an external timer.

Emergency tones have priority over all inputs except Mic 1 which shares the same priority level as the emergency tones to allow evacuation paging to take place.

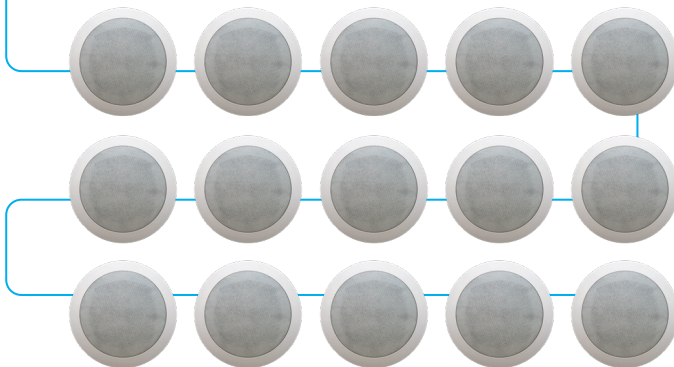

OPTIONAL

Inline 100 volt volume control VC series attenuators (10W, 25W, 50W and 100W) can be placed inline to adjust volume on a speaker run. Or use a VC-LOG VCA control connected to the rear panel for remote master volume adjustment
